



USA Rugby - Sport Goggle Usage Form

Usage of sport goggles are not allowed in contact rugby according to current IRB law 4 and Regulation 12. The International Rugby Board and USA Rugby have authorized the use of goggles in a limited pilot scenario. Interested players must apply online at the IRB at irbplayerwelfare.com/goggles, and complete this form to be considered for the pilot program. To be considered for the pilot program, Players must:

- Have a chronic eyesight condition. This includes people who require corrective lenses, people with monocular vision and people with restricted vision in one or both eyes.
- Gain a recommendation from an ophthalmologist or optometrist.
- Provide this completed form to the referee at each match where the goggles will be used, detailing the need for the participant to wear the goggles.
- Complete the application form for inclusion in the Global Law Trial (or the person for whom the applicant is a legal parent or guardian) at irbplayerwelfare.com/goggles.

***NOTE: Rugby Goggles may not be used by an individual to enable them to play contact Rugby while recovering from a temporary eye or face injury.
